The 70 historic grape suppliers are supervised by the agronomist Giovanni Pascarella and have to comply with a strict vine dressing protocol aimed at sustainability and the production of grapes of excellent quality. Another enologist, Gianfranco Zanon, is in charge of production management. The cellar's own four hectares are certified organic and its Filandetta vineyard, in the heart of the Valdobbiadene zone is well worth a visit.

Wines of impeccable style and exemplary elegance are the traits that characterize the range. The excellent Prosecco Sup. Brut Ius Naturae is an organic wine combining ripe fruit with delicate minerality."
