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### Product information

Beaune is one of the largest Côte de Beaune districts, covering 430 ha and with no less than 42 sectors classified as "premier cru".

- Appellation : Beaune
  - Sector : Longbois
  - History : a long plot of land formerly planted with trees.
  - Orientation : East
  - Domain surface area : 30a54ca
  - Slope : 2 to 5% at an altitude of 310m .
  - Date planted : 1987
  - Vinestock : SO4 et 161-49
  - Graft : Chardonnay, visual selection.
  - Soil : Clay and limestone, shallow and stony.
  - Taste : it reveals the good character of the altitude of the plot, mineral and tangy with hints of citrus and other fresh fruit.
  - Serving temperature : 12 to 14°C and it can be advisable to decant recent vintages to enhance the aroma.
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### Producer information

The Marchand (Morey St. Denis) and Grillot (Gevrey Chambertin) families have been growing vines for generations and were joined by marriage in 1950. They continue to render traditional wines without compromise. Making traditional wines without compromise, they employ slightly earlier picking (using 25% stems), natural yeasts, gentle pressing, long cold maceration and fermentation as well as little new oak. The wines are customary in color and moderate in alcohol. More approachable in their youth than wines with more oak and extract, Marchand-Grillot's wines age wonderfully with balance and finesse.

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
