Product information

Costieres de Nimes is the southernmost appellation of the Rhone Valley. It features the same varieties found in the Cotes du Rhone appellations across the river to the east. Reds from this zone are becoming increasingly common in the USA as wine lovers discover the great value and solid winemaking in wines from the region. Chateau Laval blends three varieties with Syrah dominant. Grapes are harvested and vinified separately in temperature-controlled stainless steel. The wine rests in tank for several months after blending before bottling and release.

Producer information

Chateau Laval is located between the cities of Arles and Nimes in the southernmost reaches of the Cotes du Rhone. The estate was founded in 1947 by Paul Alcaï and is operated today by Paul's daughter Martine and her husband Jean-Jacques Chemorin. There are 48 hectares under vine with most of the red grapes split evenly between Grenache and Syrah.
